

TUNE INTO YOUR

POTENTIAL 2

Overview:

“Tune Into Your potential 2” is a confidence raising and employability skills project for over 25 year olds who are not in education, employment or training.

In Swansea it is delivered at the National Waterfront Museum. We can use various venues as the project covers the regions of Swansea, Carmarthenshire and Neath Port Talbot.



The aim of the project is to increase the skills, Motivation and confidence of participants as well as providing them with an accredited qualification to help them get closer to work or education.

What makes the project unique is that it uses music and song writing as a way to build people’s confidence whilst developing their soft-skills that are essential for employment or training.

No previous music experience is required as participants will work alongside our professional musicians and skilled tutors to help ensure they reach their full potential.

Activities: Run over 5 days

- Song writing / recording / music production
- Level 1 Agored Cymru Full qualification – Personal and Social Education
- Soft Skills development (teamwork, communication, working under pressure, time management)
- Guest talks
- Group work
- Ongoing support to find work/training opportunities
- 1 to 1 further support with CV writing/interview skills

What we provide:

- Travel costs reimbursed
- Free qualification
- Group work and 1 to 1 support post course
- Support with locating and accessing onward progressions including employment, work experience, volunteering, further learning, job search activities.

Eligibility

- All participants must be 25+ and not in education employment or training
- All participants must have the right to work in UK

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- All participants must reside in Swansea, Neath Port Talbot or Carmarthenshire
- Participants must be long-term unemployed - in receipt of unemployment benefits for 12 months or more.
- If on other benefits such as employment support allowance no time restriction on ESA claimants.
- Participants who also don't claim any benefits whatsoever are also eligible.
- Participants require proof of NI number, DOB and benefits (if receiving)



Venue:

General Workshops are run at The National Waterfront Museum Swansea, Oystermouth Road, Swansea.

As an alternative to the 5 - day week course. We can also run the project for 1 day a week for 5 weeks at any venue provided by partners. This is sometimes a better solution for those candidates that may find a week long project a difficult commitment.
