Summer Holiday Provision for Disabled Children 2022

Our aim is to provide the greatest range of options for children and families across the county.

This guide provides some details of the options to choose from and includes the contact details for booking and enquiries about the individual service.

There are 3 sections in this guide:

- 2. Non-Specialist Holiday Clubs who may be able to provide support for Disabled Children
- 3. Additional Support for Children & Families who are open to our Disability Team.





1. Specialist Provision

These are services for Disabled Children who cannot access mainstream clubs or provisions. They are run by specialist providers who are registered with Care Inspectorate Wales and Commissioned by Carmarthenshire County Council.
