#### WHAT IS THE EISTEDDFOD?

The Urdd National Eisteddfod, one of Europe's largest youth touring festivals that attracts around 90,000 visitors each year, will once again be held during Whitsun week at the end of May. It is held in a different location in Wales each year. In 2024, the National Urdd Eisteddfod will visit Maldwyn.

The Eisteddfod is a competitive festival with over 15,000 children and young people under the age of 25 competing during the week in various competitions such as singing, dancing and performing.

They are the elite few from around 40,000 competitors across Wales who have won their place following local and regional rounds held in the spring months leading up to the Eisteddfod.
