



Camouflage Art

This is a fantastic and messy activity that will get the children out in the fresh air, while discussing what it means to be camouflaged, and how it can help animals in the wild.

Things you need:

Card

Paint

Items from the garden / park



First, collect some items from the garden like leaves, grass and twigs.

Using brown and green paint, cover the card.

While painting you could ask what camouflage is and why animals would use it to hide in the wild.

Whilst the paint is wet, place your camouflage garden items onto it. As the paint dries, they will stick to the card.

You could also play a game with your finished pieces of art in the garden. One person can hide their art somewhere in the garden for the others to find. See how well your art is camouflaged!
